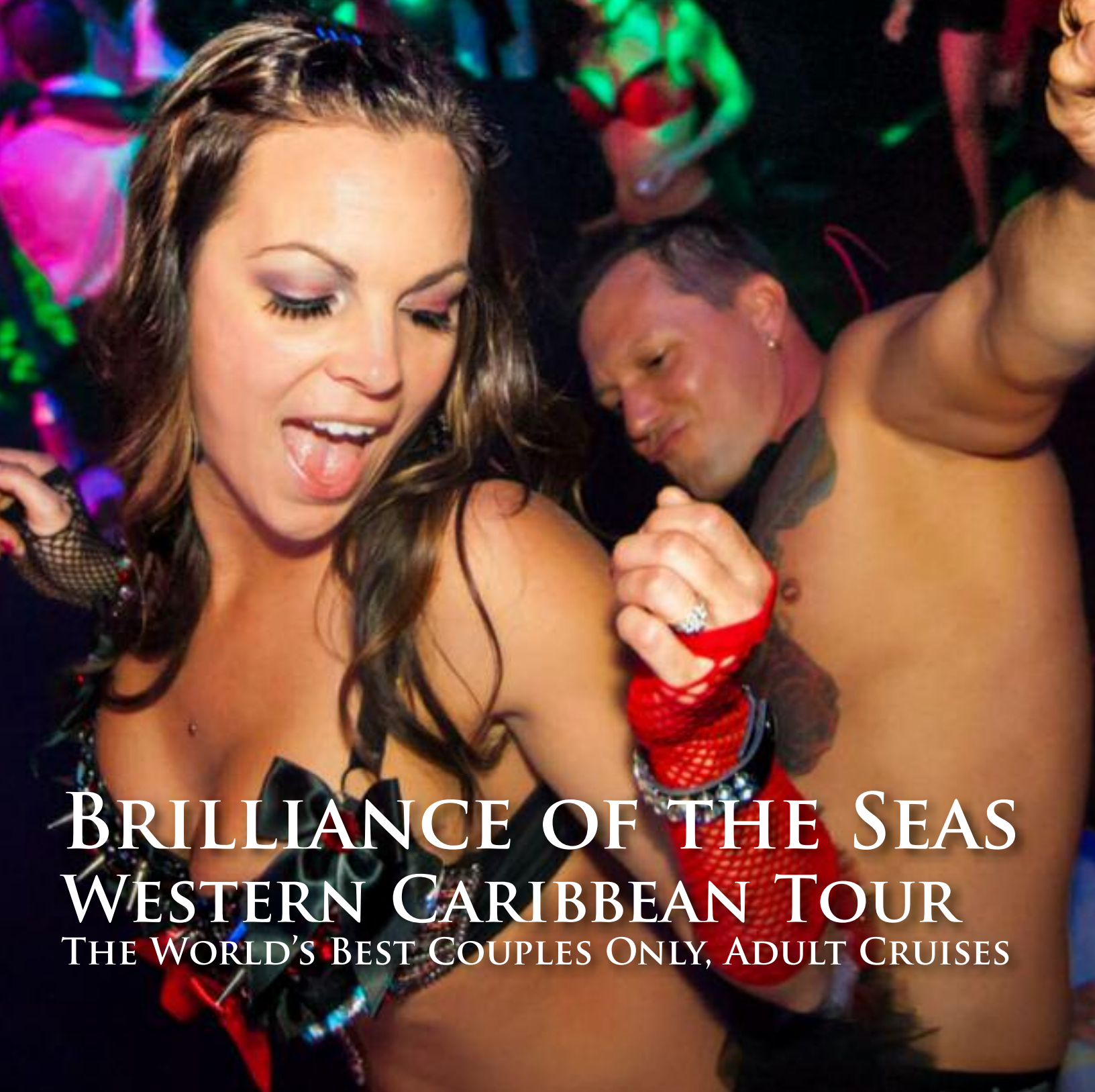

Make sure to check out your TV each morning to see our morning show for the day's highlights. In fact, you can even check the dinner menu and see how much you have spent on board from your TV set as well.

Our staff will be wearing bright Couples Cruise shirts and should be easy to find, so hit them up if you are lost or need anything. We are here to help make this your best vacation ever!

Couples Cruise 2014 Guidelines

Please help us ensure everyone has the best possible time by abiding by all of our (and Royal Caribbean's) conduct rules and by looking out for fellow Couples Cruise attendees. Your actions represent our event and will go a long way toward our acceptance in this community.

The Brilliance of the Seas security staff is very tolerant but we do not need to test their tolerance. Keep your parties private and behind closed doors. Please dress properly while walking around the ship.

The ship reserves the right to put passengers off the ship, at any port, who will not follow their rules of conduct. If this happens, you will not get a refund and you will have to make your own way home from the port. Plus, you will look really silly and your friends will laugh at you as we sail away.

Please read and adhere to the following Guidelines:

1. Respect: "No means No!" Anyone that doesn't understand this or is making unwanted advances could be subject to expulsion from the ship at the next port, without a refund.

2. Nudity Rules: Nudity is only allowed on the pool decks (11, 12), and all hallways leading to your cabin. Topless is permitted in the Couples Cruise Viking Crown Lounge / StarQuest. Please note that you cannot go nude in any elevator. You must be covered. No nudity is allowed in the restaurants, casino, shops, Centrum, lounges, or other public place not mentioned above. Please sit on a towel at all times if nude. It is just common courtesy. In going to the Couples Cruise Play Area (The Colony Club), please wear a robe or cover up.

3. Sexual Activity Rules: Feel free to get to know one another on the dance floor, exchange e-mails, or meet afterwards in your cabin, but no sexual activity is permitted in the dances, pool deck, lobby or any public place. There is a time and a place for everything: sexual activity can only take place in your private cabins or in a designated private hospitality area.

Under no circumstances can you approach any of the shipboard staff for any sexual reason. They are not permitted in your cabin or they will lose their jobs. This rule is extremely important and we know that you would not want to be escorted off the ship at the next port. Naturally, there would be no refund.

4. No Drugs: This is simple- "Just Say No." Anyone breaking this rule will be banned from any of our future events and cruises forever, again; no refund. Do not buy drugs in ports: You will be arrested.

5. Camera Policy: Taking photos of other passengers without permission is not allowed. If you are seen taking photos of groups of people without their permission, your camera can be taken by staff to be reviewed. Inappropriate photos will be deleted at the discretion of the staff supervisor. Any photos taken on board the ship are for personal use only.

Photos, or videos from this charter cruise cannot be published, printed, made public on the internet, YouTube or used for any other purpose without written approval from Couples Cruise.

6. You Must Listen to the Ship's Security & our Couple Cruise Staff: If someone says you are acting or dressed inappropriately, you probably are. Please respect the ship's security. They are here to protect you and our attendees. Anyone not adhering to our or the ship's conduct policies can be put off the ship at the next port.

7. Intoxication: If you become intoxicated and disruptive, you will be escorted to your cabin.

8. Prostituting: Passengers are not permitted to pay nor accept payment to engage in any form of entertainment or sexual activity.

9. Protect Yourself: It is your responsibility to act responsibly when it comes to personal protection.

10. Smoking: Smoking is permitted only in designated areas of the ship. Smoking is NOT permitted in any cabin or balcony. Please note that RCCL will impose a fine of \$250.00 for smoking in your cabin.

11. Have Fun: It's a rule, and it's enforced!

What is a Couples Cruise?

Hopefully, you already know what a Couples Cruise is before reading this program in your cabin.

We thought we should start off this program with a good overview of what to expect and what is expected from our passengers.

You can read the guidelines on the previous page, but I want to make sure you have a real sense of our vision and what we are trying to accomplish.

First off, a Couples Cruise is an Adults Only, Clothing Optional Cruise for couples only. We cater to a lot of different demographics including nudists, swingers, “kinky” couples into BDSM, as well as, any couple that is open minded and looking for an incredible party at sea (with no kids!).

This is not a nude cruise. Nude cruises allow nudity pretty much everywhere on board. Our cruises have clothing optional decks and allow people to be topless in our discos. Everywhere else requires clothes.

This is not a “swinger’s cruise”. We do have a lot of people on board that consider themselves “swingers” but that is probably around 30% of our passengers. Of course, there are a lot of couples on board that do not consider themselves to be in this lifestyle that sure look like it to us.

This is a Couples Cruise. A collection of open minded couples that we have seen at Fantasy Fest, lifestyle clubs, clothing optional resorts, nude cruises, Mardi Gras, BDSM conventions, strip clubs and house parties around the country.

We wanted to have a cruise where we could wear togas or lingerie without anyone caring. We wanted a place where we could suntan topless (or even nude). We wanted a cruise where the discos lasted past midnight and the adult jacuzzis were not full of giggling teenagers.

We wanted to put together something that would be so sexy it would get you excited, but also something upscale and classy so that we could invite our friends that don’t consider themselves to be kinky.

This is a Couples Cruise. We hope you will like our vision and you will come back for more of our fun and sexy cruises (and bring your friends).

Getting into your Cabin

The cabins won't be available until after 1 pm. If you get on board before then, head to the Windjammer Cafe and have lunch or go to the pool and relax or grab a drink at one of the many bars onboard.

Someone thought that not being able to get into your cabins until 1 pm was a Couples Cruise rule, but this is standard procedure on all Royal Caribbean and pretty much all cruise ships. The cabin attendants need time to get all 1,045 cabins cleaned and ready for us. The passengers from the last cruise typically do not finish leaving the ship until around 10:00 am on the day we sail.

All Inclusive Drink Packages

Royal Caribbean is now offering All Inclusive Drink Packages and they have been a big hit on our most recent charters. They are a great value and helped save many of our passengers a lot of money on their bar tabs.

You need to sign up for these packages on the very 1st day or you won't be able to get the package.

Safety at Sea

One very important issue for Couples Cruise and Royal Caribbean is Safety at Sea. If you do get the drink package, please enjoy the unlimited drinks, but don't get carried away, or we might have to literally carry you away.

The bartenders go through training and will cut off people who are too intoxicated to serve. They can also shut off your cabin key (called your SeaPass) so you can't get any drinks at any other bars.

Be a Good Partner/Friend

If your partner or a friend is getting too intoxicated, help them out and get them something to eat, some water or simply ask them to take it easy for a little while. If they are past this point, help them back to their cabin so they can sleep it off.

If you see someone who needs help, but you don't know them, alert someone on the Couples Cruise staff or call from any house phone and ask for security, we are happy to help them back to their staterooms.

Getting wasted will not enhance your cruise experience and will certainly diminish your ability to have a fun, sexy time on a Couples Cruise.

Drugs

We hate to have to bring this up. It's already mentioned on our rules form, but we want to bring it up again. Couples Cruise and Royal Caribbean has a "Zero Tolerance rule for all illegal drugs.

The main reason we have had to kick people off of our cruises (and there have been a few) is because of drugs. People have complained about their neighbors smoking pot on their balconies, drugs have been seen by Royal Caribbean staff in the open in couple's staterooms and even angry or jealous partners or friends have turned people in and we have had to put them off the ship while in port.

You don't want to be put off the ship in a foreign port. Especially if you are to be turned over to that country's local law enforcement for possession of a controlled substance.

We have even had a couple buy drugs from an undercover officer in a port sting operation. We haven't been in an Jamaican or Mexican jail, but we know that we never want to find out what they are like.

Dressing for the Playrooms

What can you wear to the playrooms? This is often a big mystery for those that have never been on a Couples Cruise or to Naughty in N'awlins. Let me explain our "Dress Code" for this sensuous and erotic Playroom:

The Couples Cruise Playroom is located on Deck 6, aft, in The Colony Club. You cannot be in street clothes to enter. This means that you need to be in a robe (we have Couples Cruise robes in the ship's store), a towel, lingerie, boxers or briefs, pajamas or something so sexy that our staff can waive you in.

Why? Because we have been to LOTS of conventions, parties, clubs and cruises where street clothes were allowed in the play areas and they all end up being social Meet & Greet without anyone actually playing.

Once we put the "No Street Clothes" rule into effect, our play areas became the most active, fun and wildest play areas in the country (now the World!). If you really are coming to play, then this rule is no big deal. If you are coming to hang out, there are better places on board.

What if we meet a couple and there is chemistry and we want to go play now and we don't want to go all the way back to our cabin? No problem, just show up, strip down to your underwear and come on in. We will give you a plastic

bag for your clothes. Don't have any underwear? Ask for a towel at the door and we will give you one to wrap around yourself.

Wayfinding Signs

To help you navigate the big boat, Royal Caribbean has also joined the digital age. Every floor has touch-screen displays that can map your route on board. These interactive signs also have the days daily schedule and the open and close hours for all of the restaurants, bars, spa and more.

Welcome Aboard / Sail Away Party

Don't miss our Sail Away Party at 4:00 pm on the Main Pool Deck (Deck 11). It is a great chance to grab a drink, meet your fellow cruisers and get started on your Couples Cruise.

Don't forget, you have to keep your swimsuits on until the Captain says it's O.K. to drop your tops. We usually need to get out away from the port before we can get permission to enjoy our clothing optional cruise.

Booking your next Couples Cruise

Stop by the Couples Cruise office on Deck 5 (Aft) and sign up for your next cruise. Our staff can answer any questions and help you pick out the best available cabin.

You can put down a deposit and hold your cabin or see what upgrades are available if you are already booked. The office will be open from 9 am till 6 pm on sea days, but will be open from 8 am till 11 am and then again from 4 pm until 9 pm on port days.

We get REALLY busy on the last sea day, so stop by early and you will not only avoid the lines, you will find the best availability.

Suite & Balcony Waiting List

Even though we are sold out of Suites for all of our cruises (and balconies for our upcoming Mexican cruise), you can still get your name put on a waiting list. When a cabin is cancelled, we go through our waiting list quickly in order to fill that cabin, so make sure you are on that list!

Playa Del Carmen is a great port and there is so much to do there with great excursions to Tulum and Xcaret which are wondrous experiences and are both highly recommended.

The beaches are European style, where you can be topless. Please note there is a lot of construction and congestion around this pier so be sure not to miss the last tender coming back to the ship. Check the times carefully and remember, we are on ship time not local time.

The Concierge Lounge, for all those in a Grand Suite or above, has now been shifted from Deck 10 to Deck 13. Plus, for our growing number of Diamond members, there is now a separate Diamond Lounge on Deck 13. Both lounges are great, but unfortunately can only be used by those who qualify.

Couples Cruise Nudity Rules

Nudity Rules Onboard

Our number one question is “When and where can we get naked?” Here is a complete list of where exactly you can be naked, topless or must be fully clothed.

Make sure to leave your clothes on until after we have left the port and the Captain has announced it is OK to do so. The Captain has the final authority.

Where you *Can* be Naked:

You can let it all hang out in these areas, but there are no sexual activities allowed in *any* public areas.

- On the Main Pool Deck & Solarium (Deck 11)
- On the Sun Decks (Decks 11, 12,)
- In the Cabin Hallways
- In the Private Play Areas (Colony Club on Deck 6)
- On your balcony while at sea
- In your (or someone else’s) cabin

There is a time and place for everything, but these places are not the ones for nudity.

- On the Rock Climbing Wall
- In the Casino or Shops
- On your balcony or any sun decks when in port
- In the Elevators
- In any Restaurants, Bars or Dining Rooms
- In the Gym or Spa

Where you *Can* be Topless:

You can’t be naked in these areas, but you can be topless.

- Any of the Pool Decks and Cabin Hallways
- In the Nightclub (Viking Crown Lounge Deck 13)

If we are given the green light, we will make an announcement. If you are not sure, just ask someone on our staff and they will check to see if it has been cleared.

Top Recommended Things to do in Playa Del Carmen



We LOVE Playa Del Carmen! It is one of our favorite places to visit. When we started going to Caribbean Reef Club (a while ago), we always drove down to Playa Del Carmen for the day. Here are some of our favorite things to do in port:

1. Xcaret: We just love Xcaret, an Eco-Park located not far from town. Don't get hung up on the eco part, it is an awesome property with underground rivers you can snorkel through, caves, exhibits, demonstrations, They also have swimming with the dolphins, a turtle farm, a butterfly garden, trails and a lot of historical exhibits and recreations.

It is the most popular attraction and we have to agree.



2. Shopping: There are a lot of great bargains in Playa Del Carmen. The cruise ships do not pull in here unless it is a private charter, so you will find a different set of shops here than you will in most port towns.

The town caters to European customers, so there are some great fashion finds as well as the traditional Mexican silver.. Just wander down 5th Street and see for yourself.

2. Clothing Optional Catamaran: Who doesn't like a clothing optional catamaran? Great music, lots of drinks and snorkeling (O.K., maybe the snorkeling first, THEN the drinks) this is a fun party cat that will sell out for sure.

4. Xel Ha: Similar to Xcaret, Xel Ha is a beautiful Eco Park with a natural aquarium park considered the largest aquarium in the world, the perfect place to perform activities in Riviera Maya. If you love nature, there is no better place than Xel-Ha to practice snorkeling and water activities like swimming with dolphins, Snuba® (combination of snorkeling and diving) or Sea Trek® (walking under water).

5. Tulum Mayan Ruins and Beach break: Tulum is a magical place and a great tour. We have been on ship tours there twice and we learned something new about the Mayan cultures and architecture on both tours. We got some of our favorite pictures while touring the Mayan ruins, especially of the beach below.



6. Relaxing on the Beach: Playa del Carmen has a large, beautiful topless beach (due to all of the Europeans that vacation here), that is very close to our pier. Just wander down, get a chair and a margarita and simply enjoy the day.

7. Cozumel: There is a lot to do on Cozumel, and it is only 12 miles away. There is a ferry boat that leaves from the same place our tenders will drop you off, so it is easy to get onto the ferry for the 45 minute ride over to the island.

We are in Playa del Carmen for 10 hours, so there is plenty of time to get back and forth from Cozumel. Note: If you book an excursion through the ship, you are guaranteed that you will make it back on the ship in time to sail. If you go on your own, well, then you are truly on your own.

7. Eat, Drink & Be Merry: There are some great restaurants in Playa del Carmen. Seafood is at the top of the list, with some of the biggest lobsters and shrimp you can find anywhere. The colossal lobsters can get pricey and we like the smaller ones better anyway.

You can also get great local Mexican dishes and some surprisingly great Italian food as well. Note: there are over 10,000 Italians living full time in Playa del Carmen.

Great Food!

Here are a couple of our favorite places to eat (email us with your favorite finds):

Yaxche: (pronounced JAG-shay)

Fifth Avenue at 22nd Street

By far the best Mexican restaurant within Playa's central core. Yaxche is one of those restaurants that pretty much makes every "top 10" list for Playa restaurants. It is the only high end restaurant in the area that serves only Mayan foods.

El Fogón:

30th Avenue at 32nd Street

Great tacos, a real locals place. In fact, you'll find taxi drivers and local families dining here for lunch and dinner at all times.

Como Como Osteria Mediterranea:

Av. 5 between 38 and 40th Street

If you want something more sophisticated, this is the place.

Club de la Cerveza:

5th Ave right before 38th Street

Want something besides Mexican beer? Try their craft beers and you'll be happy you did. They also have small plates from all over the world.

Negroamaro Italian Bar & Restaurant:

5th Ave & 34th Street

Real Italian food from a real Italian family.

Great Drinks!

Bad Boys Beach Bar:

Take 5th Ave to 4th St and take a right and go to the beach

They have some of the best live music (especially blues) on the beach. That and some tasty drinks to boot. Toes in the sand, music in your ears and a drink in your hand. Is this what they call Paradise?

Tequila Barrel:


5th Ave between 10th & 12th Streets

Spectacular Diving in Grand Cayman

Kittiwake Wreck Dive



Grand Cayman has more than 175 dive sites to choose from including steep, deep walls decorated with sponges and corals in a stunning variety of colors, and marine life such as Garden Eels, Parrot Fish and Green Sea Turtles. Other attractions include wreck diving where you can explore amazing structures and see curious marine life as well as the World's Best 12 Foot Dive: Stingray City.

Kittiwake Wreck Dive:

The USS Kittiwake was originally a submarine rescue vessel in the 6th Submarine Squadron stationed in Norfolk, VA. The Kittiwake is 251 feet long and has a 44 foot beam, and her five decks housed 85 sailors.

The Kittiwake is perfect for divers of all skill levels to enjoy and explore. The Kittiwake has many nooks and crannies where fish hide and some, like juvenile sharp-nosed puffers and schooling horse-eye jacks, have already made homes there. Situated close to Grand Cayman's west wall, the Kittiwake also offers the chance to see larger marine life, such as spotted eagle rays, turtles and green moray eels.

Stingray City



Amphitrite mermaid off Sunset Reef:

Amphitrite has been overseeing Sunset Reef for seven years now. She has graced the cover of Skin Diver Magazine, Sport Diver Magazine, Scuba Diving Magazine and numerous others.

Amphitrite is actually a 9 foot tall bronze mermaid and was carefully put underwater at the edge of Sunset Reef. Today she sits in 55' and keeps an ever present watch over the reef and is favorite for photo enthusiasts.

Cayman Walls:

Known for its amazing wall dives, beautiful coral reefs and visibility that often reaches more than 30 metres/100 feet, the Cayman Islands offer some of the best scuba diving in the Caribbean.

Your journey to the wall will commence through or over tunnels, chutes and caverns populated with lobster, shrimp, crab and copious species of fish and bottom dwellers. Look into little nooks and crannies along the way and you may spot a moray eel gazing back.

Once you reach the spectacular Cayman wall, maintain an ongoing vigil for Spotted Eagle Rays who soar gracefully like giant graceful birds flying in slow motion. Turtles and (occasionally) sharks can also be spotted swimming along Cayman's sheer walls. Black coral can be found near depths of 100ft, usually under outcrop pings or inside tunnels.

Three tiny islands make up the British Overseas Territory of the Cayman Islands, balanced precariously one side of the enormous Cayman Trench, the deepest part of the Caribbean. While synonymous worldwide with banking, tax havens and beach holidays, there's much more to this tiny, proud nation, even if you do need to look quite hard to find it.

1. Stingray City: Stingrays are cool (even if they did off Steve Irvin) and there is nothing cooler than Stingray City. There are many different options available to experience these rays up close, but no matter which one you pick (catamaran, dive boat, added beach break or turtle farm), you'll have a great time.



2. Diving: Grand Cayman is one of our favorite places to dive. Crystal clear waters, shipwrecks, dramatic walls, stingrays and sculptures make this area of the Caribbean, some of the best diving in the world.

Check out some of our recommended dive sites that can be arranged through the ship's excursion desk. You'll have plenty of time for a great two tank dive while we are in port, so if you are certified, do not miss this opportunity.

3. Seven Mile Beach: Named one of the "Ultimate Beaches" by Caribbean Travel + Life, Seven Mile Beach is only one of the many reasons why Cayman is considered the ultimate Caribbean destination and the epitome of an island getaway vacation. Located on the western shore of Grand Cayman, the Seven Mile Beach is the most well-known beach on the islands.

You can pick an excursion that includes a visit to 7 Mile Beach and many other of the popular tours like Stingray City or a Dolphin Swim.

4. Hell: Hell is a group of short, black, limestone formations located in Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands. Located in West Bay, it is roughly the size of half a soccer field. People are not allowed to be amongst the limestone formations but viewing platforms do exist for visitors.



There is a post office in Hell and it is a favorite of tourists to send their friends postcards from Hell. A visit to Hell is included on the Glass Bottom Boat and Island Tour. We did this tour on our last site Inspection and had a great time. The tour also includes a stop to the Tortuga Rum Cake outlet where you can try some free samples and make sure you try the local rum punch (yummy).

5. By Sky: Helicopter There is no better way to see the island, and the beautiful blue waters, than on a Helicopter Tour. There are only a couple of slots open for this tour, so book early if you want to fly over the islands.

6. By Sea: Submarine: The Cayman Islands are one of the top scuba diving destinations in world, and with Atlantis Submarines, you don't have to be a scuba diver to experience the underwater world. The 48 passenger Atlantis Submarine offers a unique but relative option for anyone seeking things to do in the Cayman Islands.

This is not a cheap ride, but it is a real "Bucket List" experience you will never forget!

Couples Cruise Tips, Hints & Info

If you don't do anything else, take a couple of minutes and read the next couple of pages to learn more about what is in store for you on this Couples Cruise.

This isn't your "normal" cruise, so if you've cruised before, you need to know about our special rules and events. If you haven't cruised before, then it is even more important to read.

The Onboard Waste System

One of the most important things that you have to understand is that the bathrooms are very sensitive to what is put into the toilets. This is a vacuum system, kinda like on an airplane, and it gets clogged very easily.

The ONLY things that can be put into the toilets are the ship's toilet paper and human waste. Do not flush any condoms, wet wipes, tampons or other feminine items or it will clog your toilet. Not only will it clog your toilet, but it will clog everyone downstream from you as well.

The ship's toilet paper is very thin; it is a special material that completely dissolves in water and is made especially for vacuum systems like this. We had a couple of bad clogs on our last Couples Cruise and it was mainly because of baby (wet) wipes. These wipes do not break down (yes, even the flushable ones) and flushing them will clog the system.

We are putting waste baskets in every bathroom with a plastic bag that will be emptied out a couple of times a day, so you won't have to flush any of the prohibited items. Please use them!

Now that we've gotten that out of the way, let's move on to more pleasant topics.

Help Desk

If you want to book a future Couples Cruise or you have a question, just stop by our Couples Cruise Help Desk located on Deck 5 next to the aft elevators above Guest Services. It will be open most days from

If you have a question that pertains to the ship, go to Guest Services on Deck 4, our Help Desk is just for Couples Cruise questions.

You're on Vacation: Act like it!

You are never going to see these people again (well, maybe some of them), so let your hair down and have some fun. If you wait until the last day to get crazy, you'll look back on this cruise and think of all the fun you could have had.

With the coming of Oasis of the Seas, Royal Caribbean introduced a new Italian specialty restaurant Giovanni's Table, a more informal trattoria-style venue. It is easy to spread colds or viruses on board a ship or at a resort or anywhere that a lot of people are close together for a while. Especially if that cruise or resort has super friendly people that are hugging and kissing each other more than most...

Here are some tips that might help you avoid getting the "Cruise Crud":

1. Get a Flu Shot: You should get the flu shot 2 weeks prior to your cruise to make sure the antibodies have time to build up in your bloodstream. You can get these at local pharmacies now, which makes it a lot easier than having to go to your doctor.

2. Get a B12 Shot: You can take B12 supplements, but getting a shot right before you go will be 90% more effective. Most Urgent Care clinics will give you a B12 shot for around \$20. You'll have more energy and feel better.

3. Wash your hands with Soap and Hot Water: You probably can't do anything more effective than washing your hands several times a day with soap and water. Many places on the ship have antibacterial hand sanitizer, but there is a growing concern that these antibacterial soaps can make you more resistant to antibiotics which can lead to hard to cure infections.

The FDA does not recommend replacing soap and water with antibacterial sanitizers but that it can be used to supplement your on board precautions.

4. Take Multivitamins: This is essentially what Airborne and Emergen-C are. The more vitamins you have, the better your immune system will work. Make sure you are getting plenty of Vitamin C and B Complex in your multivitamins.

5. Gargle with Mouthwash or Salt Water: Warm salt water can remove viruses from the tonsils and adenoids

that line the back of your throat region. Another side effect: your breath will smell better!

A viral infection is by far the most common cause of a sore throat, and there are several different viruses that can lead to the common cold and an upper respiratory infection.

If you get a sore throat on board, you can drink tea with honey, even whiskey helps, but the best thing you can do is to go to the ship's infirmary and get treated early.

If you do all of the above and you still start to feel bad, go see the ship's doctor. They specialize in sea sickness, colds and flu and other commonly passed illnesses that occur on board ships.

Some don't go and end up spreading their germs all over the ship because they think that it will cost a fortune or they might get quarantined.

Trust us, while not cheap, you would gladly pay a little today in order to be treated before you get really sick. They can shorten a cold or sickness if they can treat you early on. It's worth it.

As for being quarantined, the doctors only do this in rare cases, so get down to the infirmary at the 1st sign you might be sick. You'll be glad you did.
